

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
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

Amy Barnes, BS, RN, 2017 NSM Rosalie Mirenda Education Award ~ Amy is a Nurse



Leader on a 49 bed adult psychiatric unit at Parkview Behavioral Health in Fort Wayne, Indiana. Amy earned her Bachelor of Science degree in nursing and a minor in psychology from IPFW. Amy was introduced to the NSM as a nursing student by Sarah Beckman, and under Professor Beckman's tutelage has had opportunities to

present NSM focused projects at the 2015 NSM Symposium in Philadelphia, PA, 2015 Sigma Theta Thau International Honor Society of Nursing Conference in Las Vegas, NV and the 2015 Xi Nu-at Large Research Symposium in Fort Wayne, IN. Amy was invited to share her senior quality improvement project in chapter 1 of The Neuman Systems Model: Celebrating Academic-Practice Partnerships by Beckman and Fawcett. In 2017, Amy received a NSM Rosalie Mirenda Education Award while attending the 2017 NSM Symposium in Utrecht, Netherlands. Amy continues to grow in appreciation for and in application of the NSM in her professional practice.
